The Plan: Follow Jesus for real.

Four Rhythms of Jesus:

1. Engaging in God's Word.

After three days they found him in the temple courts, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.

2. Prayer.

But He was also curiously stronger, when the tempter came to Jesus.

Matthew 4:3 (VOICE)

3. Rest.

John 3:22, Mark 4:38, Mark 6:31-32, Luke 10:38-42

4. Real Community. (Confession and Celebration)

John 3:22, John 10:38-42, Mark 14:12-26, John 2:1-12

The Peace: Living as who you really are (no matter what).

Final Thought: When you follow the <u>ways</u> of Jesus, you discover who you <u>really are</u>, and live the life you've been <u>created to live</u>.
